

How to REGISTER TO VOTE:

- Use **Blue or Black Ink** only to complete the application, *PLEASE DO NOT USE PENCIL.*
- Check **Yes** or **No** box to questions **A and B**. If you answer "**No**" in response to either question, **do not** complete the voter registration card – you are not eligible to register to vote.
- Check the reason box that applies to you: (**New Registration, Address Change, Party Change OR Name Change.**)
- Leave these sections **blank**: **Precinct Code, Precinct Name, Town and Other Code.** (For the County Clerk's use.)
- Please write in your correct **Social Security Number, Date of Birth, County, Work Phone, Home Phone, Gender, Last Name, First Name and Middle Name.**
- Circle the correct **Suffix** (Jr., Sr., II, III, IV) (If it applies to you).
- Write in your **Permanent Address where you live.**
- Write in the address where you receive your mail, **ONLY if it is different from the address above.**
- Check one of the political parties boxes. If you check "**Other,**" please write in the name of your chosen political party. If you choose "**Other,**" you are eligible to vote only for nonpartisan offices in any primary election. You may, however, vote for any candidate of your choice in all general and special elections. Note: You may change your political party affiliation at any time on or before December 31st to remain eligible to vote in the following primary election.
- Read the voter declaration, **Sign and Date. If your signature is marked with an "X", you must have two witnesses sign your voter registration card.** Review your completed application to ensure you have marked all appropriate boxes and filled in all information fields including signing and dating the voter declaration. If you fail to complete any part, your application process will be delayed.
